



Litter-Free Neighborhood Program Intern Position Description

Clean up Nepal is a volunteer-driven organization that aims to create a cleaner, healthier Nepal by tackling the country's serious waste management issues. We are a ground-up, community-led movement that values stakeholder engagement and volunteerism to create change.

Clean up Nepal is undertaking a Litter-Free Neighborhood Program at the peri-urban settlements of Machhegaon, Thaiba and Thankot. A litter-free neighborhood is one where residents are aware of the concepts of sustainable living --a vision of a community that produces minimal waste through appropriate and smart choices.

We are seeking 2 interns per site to be actively involved in this community based project over a 6 month period. Please note that Clean up Nepal interns are not paid. However, basic costs related to lunch and travel will be provided when visiting the communities.

Responsibilities:

- Work closely with the Clean up Nepal Country Manager and the community to plan, coordinate and manage the Litter-Free Neighborhood Program;
- Assist the community with their monthly waste collection drives;
- Assist in developing and carrying out various waste management training and programs for the community;
- Build networks and strengthen relations with community members;
- Collect and submit information required to prepare reports;
- Work closely with the Country Manager and other members to monitor and evaluate the progress of the program activities; and
- Perform other program-related duties, including participation in meetings and programs, as and when assigned.

Skills, experience and interest:

- A Bachelor degree in Community Development/Environment/Social Science(Nearing completion or completed);
- Highly independent and self-motivated;
- Willing to work closely with communities;
- Ability to travel to these communities at least twice a month.

The intern is expected to designate 4 hours each second Saturday at one of the above communities and an additional 1-3 hours per week for the program. They are expected to uphold Clean up Nepal's [Code of Conduct](#).
